### Definition of Assessments:

**ACCESS:** This assessment was developed by the WIDA (developed by the University of WI – Madison) consortium and administered to English Language Learners in order to measure progress toward meeting Minnesota’s standards for English language development. **Fastbridge:** Computer-Adaptive Tests backing by \$8 million in research and 40+ collective years of research. The assessments provide a reliable measure of broad achievement and predict high-stakes test outcomes with high accuracy in both reading and math. The tests

**MCA & MTAS:** The Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCA) and alternate assessment Minnesota Test of Academic Skills (MTAS) are the state tests that help districts measure student progress toward Minnesota's academic standards and also meet federal and state legislative requirements. Students take one test in each subject. Most students take the MCA, but students who receive special education services and meet eligibility requirements may take the alternate assessment MTAS instead.
